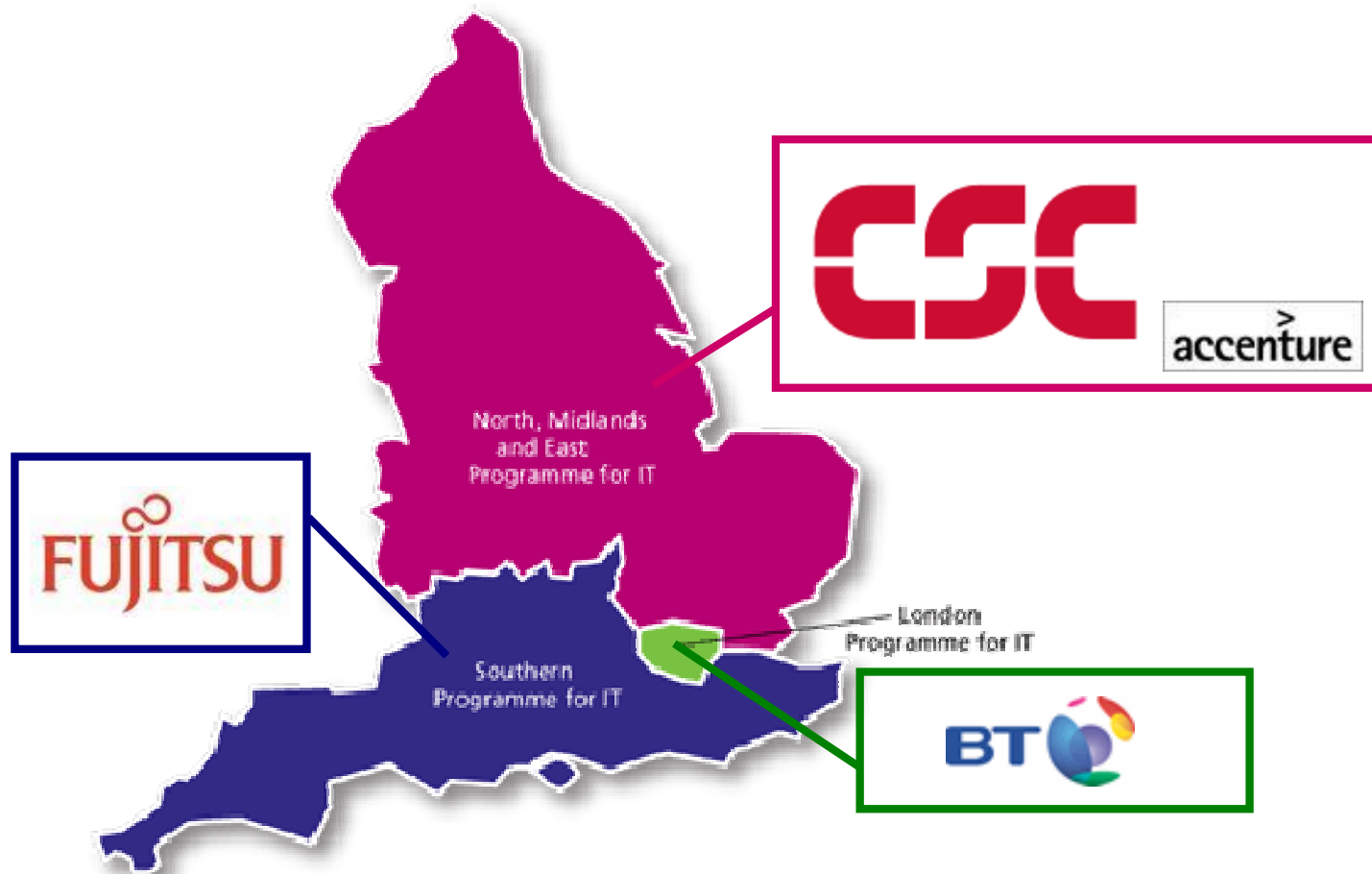
## *eHealth systems and CfH in England.*

The NHS has finalised a range of Framework Contracts through open competition to provide additional capacity and capability in the supply of IT services to the NHS.

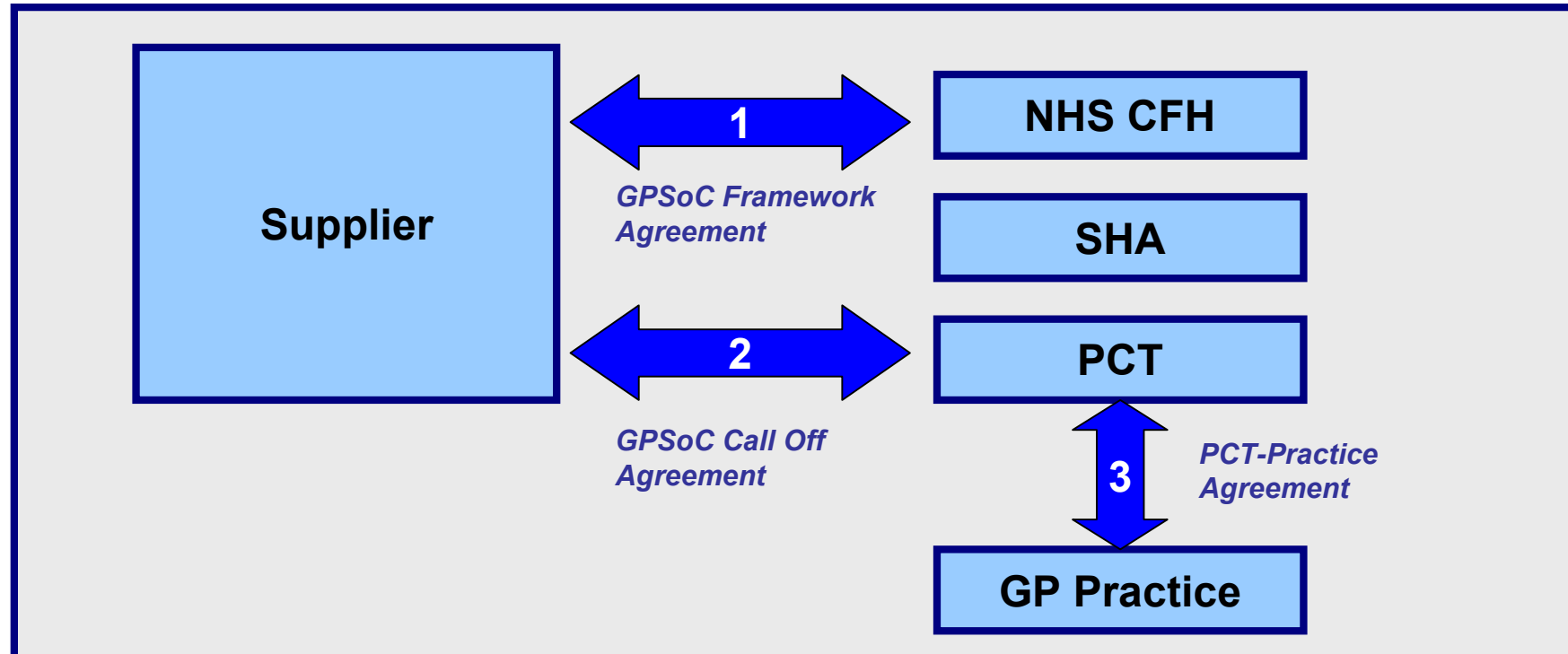
The Contracts have been divided into business 'Lots' as follows:

**Lot 1 - Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Services**

**Lot 2 - Clinical Information Technology (CIT) Services**

**Lot 3 - Hardware, Infrastructure and Associated (HIA) Services**

**Lot 4 - Testing Environments and Related Services (TERS)**
